- 4.1 Info: For every 1 person experiencing homelessness, there are 81 experiencing food insecurity. NM has an aging population (3 way tie for oldest in country).
- 4.2 Meals on Wheels coordinates with home health care, referrals for adaptive equipment in home. Recipients have fewer falls, less loneliness. They deliver 40,000 meals /week in ABQ, have 500 volunteers (and need more). They offer regular, diabetic, renal friendly, cut, puree, cube sized, vegetarian meals. They also bring a newspaper, have pet adoption, groomer, cat/dog food delivery, house curb # painting, birthday cards, daffodils...
