- 4. Membership reminder (by Janet Manry): No dues are required to attend or vote in any neighborhood organization. Voluntary dues are welcome and appreciated. You may vote if you are a resident, business owner or property owner in the RANA area. You can sign up for the newsletter at no cost.
- 5. Guest speaker: Maria Wolfe, Social Services Coordinator, Public Safety ECHO, Albuquerque Police Department.
- 5.1 Maria provided information and a handout regarding when to call 911 (for emergencies when an individual's life, safety or property is immediately in danger or there is a crime in progress), when to call 311 (to report concerns to be addressed during M-F 8-5 business hours), and when to call 242-COPS (2677) (e.g., residential or commercial burglaries, loud parties, suspicious activities). If appropriate you can request Albuquerque Community Services to address apparent mental health issues).
- 5.2 Atlas 1 (https://atlasone.app) is the new app to make police reports online. The former APD app no longer works.
- 5.3 You can use ABQ311 app to connect to 311 services.
- 5.4 Maria's email is mwolfe@cabq.gov. There is also an APD substation at 4 th and Central where you can make a police report.
- 6. New Business
- 6.1 Saba & John attended from Arrowsoul Trading Post: They have just moved into the formerly Red Planet business site across the street. Red Planet has moved to another location. Arrowsoul Trading Post is indigenous owned, will provide various products including t-shirts, and is planned for opening soon.
- 6.2 Bennie Hargrove Park dedication occurred May 18. The mayor, Representative Pamela Herndon, Parks & Recreation supervisor, Bennie's family, and many from the community attended. Seven trees were planted and the bench dedicated.
- 6.3 Monthly activities are planned for the Bennie Hargrove Park for first Fridays just before the Art Walk. June 2 from 4-7 will be the Fashion Show and Clothing Swap, July 7 from 4-7 will be Family Fun Day, August 4 4-7 will be OffCenter Arts Evening, September 8 6:30-9:30 will be Movie Night (options for movies will be distributed for vote), and October 6 4-7 will be Harvest & Heritage Potluck. August 1 will be National Night Out.
- 6.4 The first RANA rounds was held and was successful, with two hosts. The next RANA rounds will be June 23. Nancy Kilpatrick is the organizer. If you are interested, let her know. She

will send out an email about two weeks before June 23 for those interested to respond, and she will then organize who goes where. Two hosts have volunteered so far for this event.

6.5 RANA support of the Run for the Zoo went well, was enjoyable for runners and neighbors, and there is support to do this again next year.

6.6 Mauro distributed a sign up sheet for volunteers for the Neighborhood Night Out August 1.
